DOORS OPEN

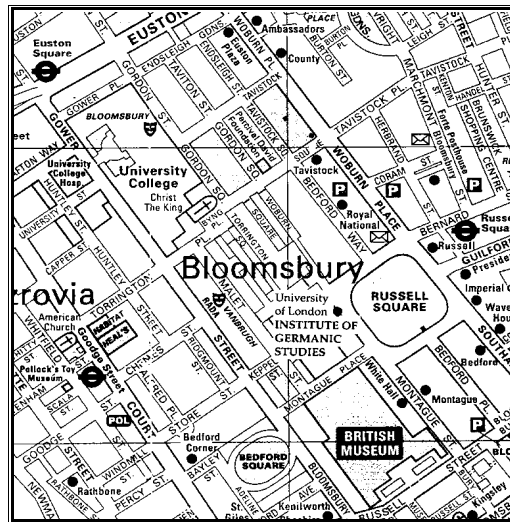
The Institute opens 30 minutes before the first lecture commences. Library hours remain as advertised.
