## Plaintiff Demands Balance of German Special Deposit Fund to Defray Own Claims

WASHINGTON, Oct. 31 -- Payment of the Black Tom and Kingsment of the Black Tom and Kings-land sabotage claims awards an-nounced yesterday by Justice Rob-erts, umpire of the Mixed Claims Commission, is opposed in a suit filed here today by the Zimmerman & Forshay Assets Realization Cor-poration of New York.
