- To extend the jurisdiction of the United States District Court, Territory of Hawaii, over the Midway Islands, Wake Island, Johnston Island, Sand Island, Kingman Reef, Kure Island, Baker Island, Howland Island, Jarvis Island, Canton Island, and Enderbury Island, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 That the jurisdiction of the United States District Court,
 - 4 Territory of Hawaii, be, and the same is hereby, extended
 - 5 to all civil and criminal cases arising on or within the Mid-
 - 6 way Islands, Wake Island, Johnston Island, Sand Island,
 - 7 Kingman Reef, Kure Island, Baker Island, Howland Island,
 - 8 Jarvis Island, Canton Island, Enderbury Island, and the
 - 9 waters adjacent thereto. All civil acts and deeds consum-
