Reference your secret telegram of 1st February  
No. 17. His Majesty's Government in New Zealand agree that  
discussion of the topics set out under (d) (g) and (h)  
of my telegram No. 9 of 22nd January is merely exploratory.  
No reply has yet been received from His Majesty's Government  
in the Commonwealth of Australia regarding the date of the  
Conference or Agenda. His Majesty's Government in New  
Zealand note with pleasure that His Majesty's Government  
in the United Kingdom are endeavouring to facilitate  
meeting of Conference in the latter half of March.
