Please inform New Zealand Government that War Office
have now appointed as their representative at Pacific
Conference Major-General P.J. Mackesy. He will leave London
by air 24th March and should arrive New Zealand 12th April.

not be necessary for Mackesy to bring uniform owing to
restrictions on baggage.
