COMMONWEALTH OF AUSTRALIA.

Your telegrams of March 17th No. 52 and No. 53.
The Minister for Civil Aviation has informed me that
having regard to the attitude of the United Kingdom
Government, which he fully appreciates, and to the views
of the New Zealand Government, item (j) will presumably
remain on the agenda; that he is therefore discussing
with the Prime Minister the question of sending a Civil
Aviation authority to the Conference; and that he will
advise me as soon as a decision is reached.
