NEW ZEALAND

From the United Kingdom High Commissioner in New Zealand.

Dated 14th April, 1939. Received 10.59 a.m., 14th April.

No. 84. Secret.

My telegram No. 83. Agenda proposed by New Zealand Delegation as in the Governor General's secret telegram of the 22nd January No. 9 was adopted by Conference.

2. New Zealand delegates opened a general discussion on strategic problems in which they raised certain questions to which the United Kingdom delegates then replied.

3. Items (a) and (b) of the agenda were then considered by the Conference.
