NEW ZEALAND

From the United Kingdom High Commissioner in
New Zealand.

Dated 7th June 1939. Received 7.40 a.m., 7th June.

Your secret telegram No.60 27th May. New Zealand
Government, on the whole, see no advantage in communicating
parts one and two of the Conference Report to the Canadian
Government, as they feel that they are of no particular
interest to Canada.

You would, I gather, not wish me to press the
suggestion.

2. I understand that the consent of the Commonwealth
Government has now been secured by the New Zealand Government
to the communication of part three to the Canadian Government
and that it will be sent by steamship "Niagara" due
Vancouver June 30th. (See your secret telegram to the
Governor General of the 22nd May No.63).
