It is assumed that a firm estimate of the cost which it is appreciated may vary to some extent from the approximate estimate in the Conference Report, will be furnished in due course by New Zealand Government who will also indicate their wishes as to arrangements for the payment of the United Kingdom contribution (i.e. half above estimate).
