Mr. RANDOLPH introduced the following joint resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

JOINT RESOLUTION

For acquisition of British islands in the Caribbean and British Honduras.

- 1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the President is hereby requested to enter into negotia-
4 tions in such manner as he may deem appropriate, with the
5 Government of Great Britain for the acquisition by the
6 United States of the islands of the Bermudas; the Bahamas—
7 Jamaica with the Turks, Caicos, and Cayman Islands; Trini-
8 dad and Tobago; Barbados; the Leeward Islands—Antigua,
9 Saint Kitts, Nevis, Dominica, Montserrat, and Virgin
10 Islands; the Windward Islands—Grenada, The Grenadines,
11 Saint Lucia, and Saint Vincent; together with British Hon-
12 duras, in part payment for the indebtedness of such govern-
13 ment to the United States.

British islands in the Caribbean and British

Honduras:

by the Senate and House of Representatives

of the United States of America, in Congress assembled,

do hereby enact into law that the

President be and he may deem appropriate with the

United States of the islands of the Bahamas—

1. the islands of the Bahamas; the Bahamas—

2. Jamaica with the Turks, Caicos, and Cayman Islands; Virgin

3. the island of Tobago; Barbados; the Leeward Islands—Antigua,

4. Saint Kitts, Nevis, Dominica, Montserrat, and Virgin

5. Islands; the Windward Islands—Grenada, The Grenadines,

6. Saint Lucia, and Saint Vincent; together with British Hon-

7. duras in full payment for the independence of such govern-

8. ment to the United States.
