With reference to Sir Ronald Lindsey's despatch No. 991 of 4th September, 1934 and to previous correspondence regarding the activities of the Ghadr party, I transmit to you herewith a copy of a letter from the India Office requesting that the United States Government may be approached with a view to the prevention or the restriction of the circulation of the Ghadr organ the "Hindustan Ghadr".
