I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of your note of the 7th January informing me that the treaty between New Zealand and the United States of America signed on the 6th September last, amending in their application to New Zealand certain provisions of the treaty for the advancement of peace between the United Kingdom and the United States of September 15th, 1914, had been ratified on the part of the United States. I am informing His Majesty's Government in New Zealand accordingly and am requesting instructions regarding the exchange of ratifications of this treaty.
