(a) Employment of British Subjects of Military Age

~~Reference was made to circular issued by the Secretary on this subject under date 13th September (copy attached Exhibit "A"). It was agreed that all Missions would make examination to ascertain the position relating to employees under the age of 30. When that had been completed it might be desirable to make a further enquiry regarding those in the age groups - 30/35 and 35/40.~~

Air Marshal Harris asked that consideration be given in this connection to the possibilities of dealing with British subjects of military age in the U.S. who were not employed in any British Mission. It was agreed that though the Council had no jurisdiction in the matter it might, after consideration of its own position, raise the subject in discussion with the British Embassy.
