I have said nothing about censorship in this telegram because we went into the question exhaustively in London some time ago. Such are our laws that we can apparently do nothing to stop messages going out unless they imperil the safety of the armed forces. One can ask a correspondent not to send a message, or ask him to correct it as being wrong in its facts, but there is no authority to stop it. This being so I am afraid it is no use trying to invoke the censorship.
