Substantive I have gone over this with Miss Haslett who agrees with me that the Committee which has been set up in London is a very interesting *and* one. She thinks that it would be a good idea to fit ~~in~~ requests which we may receive from students, social workers or other technical people into this scheme. I, personally, am very glad to hear of it because, while the numbers of people who wish to go to Britain under this heading are not great, many would be useful as individuals and their presence in England would be taken by their own colleagues in this country as a sort of token representation of their respective professions.

Miss Haslett decided that it might help to expedite the whole scheme if she were to write directly to the Ministry of Labour, informing them of the existence of this Committee, and so has written the enclosed letters to the Home Secretary and Sir Frank Tribe.
